Our staff will work with you to begin the process of healing from the effects drugs and alcohol have had on personal relationships and develop healthy boundaries and positive communication skills.

Services are offered free of charge and include:

- Peer-to-peer coaching
- Case management
- Educational workshops
- Family advocacy
- Wellness plan development
- Connections to 12 Step meetings and other recovery support groups
- Treatment resource information
- Information about obtaining and using Naloxone (Narcan)

ReConnections is open to families and individuals living in Camden, Gloucester, Burlington, Cumberland, Salem, Ocean, Atlantic, and Cape May Counties.
