IDENTIFYING RED FLAGS OF ASD

| Appears to not hear well or react to sounds | Self-injury inducing activities or movements-scratching, slapping, or head-banging |
| Resists touch & eye contact | Develops routines & gets very upset if they are disrupted |
| Prefers to play alone | Appears clumsy or uncoordinated |
| Delayed speech or lack of speech, including nonverbal | Odd movements-walks on toes, has exaggerated or stiff movements |
| Speaks with abnormal tone or rhythm-may appear sing-song like or robotic | Fascinated with minor details |
| Takes words & expressions literally | Sensory sensitive-light, sound, touch |
| Has difficulty holding a conversation | Indifferent to pain or temperature |
| Doesn't express emotion & has difficulty interpreting others' emotions | Seeming lack of imagination or creativity |
| Inappropriate social interactions-passive, aggressive, or disruptive | Fixates on object or activity with abnormal intensity. |
| Repetitive movements-rocking or hand flicking are common | |
